

ROTARY CLUB OF HOBART – ART SHOW 2024 - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must be original works.
2. There is a limit of three (3) works per Artist (or 1 Table per artist) – this does not include any Phil-Art-Thropic Entries.
3. The number of works exhibited will be limited (excluding Phil-Art-Thropic entries) to a maximum of 500
4. Entries must not have been exhibited in a prior Rotary Club of Hobart Art Show.
5. All paintings and photographs must be suitably framed and be able to be hung 'as is'.
6. All exhibits must be for sale.
7. All items are accepted, displayed and returned at the owner's risk.
8. Cost of entry is as follows:
 - a. \$10 per individual entrant; plus
 - b. \$15 per art piece entered – i.e the cost of entering 2 pieces will be $\$10 + 2 \times \$15 = \$40$
 - c. Youth entry (16 years and under) \$10 entry fee only (one piece only to be entered)
9. The Rotary Club of Hobart retains a commission of 20% of the sale price for all items sold, except for Auction items and Phil-Art-Thropic entries.
10. The Rotary Club of Hobart reserves the right to not display any item.

Bank Account for Payments for Sales

Please note we will send payments for Sales directly to Bank Accounts this year.

Guidelines for Entries:

We want to provide exhibits which will appeal to our audience and which will meet the needs of our sponsors. This may be a subjective process and the following guidelines are provided.

General

- Works need to be hand prepared and individual (not mass produced)
- Works should be Art rather than Craft, have artistic merit, and be saleable
- We wish to support new and emerging local artists
- The Art Show committee reserve the right to decide if a work meets the shows guidelines and may refuse to accept work at their discretion
- Traditional and new medium may be used, textiles must be hung items only

Size of work

- Miniatures must be 100sq cm or less before framing.
- Hung works should not exceed 1.5m x 1.5m.
- Young artists – hung works should not exceed 750mm x 750mm
- If your hung work is larger, or you have other large items, please contact us at artshow@rotaryhobart.org or make notes in the entry form.

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

1. Registration close when the number of works entered reaches 500 or on **Friday 23rd August 2024** (whichever occurs first)
2. Delivery of artworks to Derwent Room **Friday 13th September 2024 8.00–11.00 a.m.**
3. Opening of the Art Show **Friday 13th September 2024. 6pm**
4. Collection of unsold artworks **Sunday 15th September 2024 4:30pm–5:30 p.m.**

ROTARY CLUB OF HOBART CENTENARY PRIZE (FEATURE PRIZE)

This year the Rotary Club of Hobart is celebrating 100 years of service to the community. This prize will be a \$500 cash prize and 1 night stay in a Suite at Wrest Point including breakfast (valued at \$520). If entering this section your piece must incorporate "100". It is up to you as the artist how you interpret that.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARDS

All visitors to the Art Show will be given a voting slip and asked to nominate three choices for the best art work in the Show. Prizes to the value of \$300 first prize, \$200 second and \$100 for third will be awarded at the conclusion of the exhibition. Winners will be notified and presented with their prize at a Rotary Club of Hobart meeting.

PEACOCK FAMILY MEMORIAL "Hangers" AWARD

This award of \$250 is presented through the Rotary Club of Hobart. It is named in honour of our late Club member, and long-serving 'hang man' for the Art Show—Fred Peacock. A panel from within the Rotary Club of Hobart will select the successful recipient for this Award, who will be presented with their prize at a Rotary Club of Hobart meeting.

ROBIN HOOD MEMORIAL AWARD

This award of \$250 is presented through the Rotary Club of Hobart and named in honour of our late Club member, and stalwart of the Art Show—Robin Hood. The Award is presented as an encouragement award and selected by members of the Hood family. The Award is presented at a Rotary Club of Hobart meeting.

ARTERY AWARD

This sponsored award for \$600 goes to a UTAS art school student, selected in conjunction with UTAS based on marks and personal criteria. The money is intended to help with their university studies and to procure art materials, as well as recognise their achievement. A certificate is presented at a Rotary Club of Hobart meeting; the student gets to exhibit in the Art Show at no cost.

CITY OF HOBART PRIZE

This prize of \$300 will be awarded to the best piece across any display category that encapsulates some part of the Hobart Local Government Area. The winner will be selected by a representative of the Hobart City Council, or a panel from within the Rotary Club of Hobart if none is available.

INDIGENOUS ART PRIZE

This prize of \$300 will be awarded to the best indigenous artists. The winner will be selected by the sponsor of this prize, or a panel from within the Rotary Club of Hobart if none is available.

PEOPLE & NATURE PRIZE

This prize of \$150 will be awarded to the best people or nature piece. The winner will be selected by the sponsor of this prize, or a panel from within the Rotary Club of Hobart if none is available.

TOM SAMEK PRIZE

This prize of \$250 will be award to the piece that best expresses an element of humour. The winner will be selected by the sponsor of this prize, or a panel from within the Rotary Club of Hobart if none is available.

CATEGORY PRIZES

A generous non-cash prize will be awarded to the best piece in each display category. The winner will be selected by the donating prize sponsor for each category, or a panel from within the Rotary Club of Hobart if the sponsor is not available.
